**New Archdeacon of Dorking** - The Bishop of Guildford, the Rt Revd Andrew Watson, has today announced that the Revd Martin Breadmore will take up the position of Archdeacon of Dorking later this year, the son of Jacky and Gordon Breadmore. Martin is currently the Director of Ministry for the Kensington Area of the Diocese of London, with responsibility for the training and development of clergy and lay people. As the lead person for training clergy after ordination he has been committed to ensuring that curacies enable training incumbents and curates to flourish in their ministry together. Martin is no stranger to Guildford, having previously served as associate minister of St Paul's Camberley for more than four years. Before moving to London Diocese he was Vicar of St Patrick's Wallington in the Diocese of Southwark for almost nine years.
